#### **Superintendent Vacancy Notice**



At the September 19, 2022 Anchorage Independent Board of Education meeting, Dr. Kelley Ransdell announced her retirement, effective on July 1, 2023. Dr. Ransdell has been integral to the success Anchorage has experienced over the past 10 years. The Board recognizes the contributions of Dr. Ransdell to the continued growth and success of Anchorage School during her tenure as truly exceptional. We know we can count on Dr. Ransdell to continue serving our community's students and staff with excellence for her remaining months as our district's leader.

At this time, the Board is seeking a professional search consultant to assist with all phases of the superintendent search process, including timeline development, stakeholder meetings, surveys, advertising and selection of the most qualified individual for the role. The Board intends to name a search firm at the October 17, 2022 meeting.

Upon establishing a timeline with the selected search firm, a screening committee will be formed in accordance with KRS 160.352 to provide recommendations to the Board. Screening committee members will be elected by our teachers, classified employees, principals, and parent-teacher organization in the upcoming weeks.

Finding the next Anchorage Independent Superintendent is a community-wide endeavor. The Board hopes that you will consider joining this important work as opportunities are announced in the upcoming weeks in order to help identify, recruit and select the most qualified individual to carry on Anchorage Independent's tradition of high academic standards and nurturing well-rounded students.

- the reason for running for a committee seat
- the reasons why they should be selected for membership on the committee.

Email submissions should include the subject line "APS Standing Committee Submission." **Parent submissions will be reviewed at the October 3**, **2022**, **School Council meeting**, and those selected will be contacted after the council meeting with terms beginning immediately.

#### **Standing Committees**

Committees are designated as Standing Committees when the duties are of an ongoing nature, the functions/tasks to be conducted are an integral part of the responsibilities of the Council and there exists a need for continuity across multiple school years. The Board's Strategic Plan currently in effect shall determine the hierarchy of related Council committee reporting structure for a given academic year. In years the Strategic Plan does not include committees working in the following areas, the Council will maintain Standing Committees that report directly to the Council in the following areas:

- 1. School Organization
- 2. School Environment
- 3. Student Activities

Annually, the Council will determine a detailed charge statement for each Standing Committee. This charge statement will include information about a specific area, need, or concern(s) to be addressed. Click here to view the current charge statements. Standing Committees will provide reports to Council on their progress in meeting the goals set by Council. Should the Standing Committee complete the goals set in the Charge Statement, they may provide information to Council pertaining to additional areas of focus. The Council may then establish a new Charge Statement at that time.

The Chairperson, or a designated representative from each Standing Committee, will provide a report to the Council at least once per year or as determined by the annual Charge Statement developed by Council. Council members also may request additional reports and updates from a Standing Committee at their discretion.

During the next few weeks, we enthusiastically invite all APS families, as well as all Anchorage community families to join the APS Library partnership with Martha Jane Potter Elementary School in Whitesburg, Kentucky. As a result of the recent floods in Eastern Kentucky, their school library was totally destroyed, losing all its books. The Anchorage community can now help rebuild the Martha Jane Potter School's library by purchasing ANCHORS (books) through a link set up by Blue Marble Books, APS's Book Fair host. The link will be live until the last day of the Book Fair (November 10). When you purchase ANCHORS for \$20, they will be

exchanged for library books, selected by the Martha Jane Potter Elementary School librarian, to best meet the needs of their students and faculty. Our school library has 14,000+ titles and as a community, we are aiming for at least 250 ANCHORS, with hopes to exceed our goal, to help refill the demolished Martha Jane Potter School library with amazing books for all of their students.
