Dear Anchorage School Families,

The Anchorage Independent School District offers a choice of healthy meals each school day. We strongly discourage meal charges, but we understand that an occasional emergency makes it necessary to charge a meal. Parents are encouraged to utilize our online system (www.MySchoolBucks.com) to monitor student balances and deposit money in students' accounts using a checking account or a credit card.

Our Anchorage Board policy states the following:

“When a student accumulates more than \$100.00 in charges, the Superintendent/ designee shall initiate the established collection process to include notification of parents and appropriate follow-up. If parents have not contacted the Cafeteria Manager or submitted the amount indicated within ten (10) working days from the date of the final notice, the debt will be considered delinquent and may be directed to the Board Attorney.”

This school year, the following process will be in place:

- Students with a negative balance will not be allowed to charge a la carte items. This includes ice cream, extra entrees, and snacks.
- Parents will be notified after their child's charges reach \$50. If a child's account continues to be delinquent and reaches \$100, the child will only be allowed to purchase an alternative meal.
